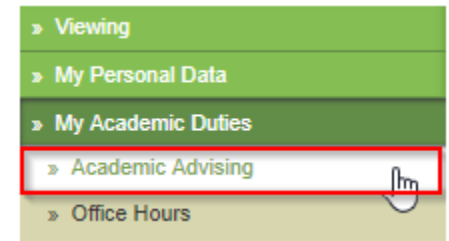


Explaining Search Parameters in The Student Academic Advising Screen

Target Audience: Student Advisors

The academic advising screen contains many search parameters most of which are self-explanatory. In this tutorial we highlight several parameters that may not be so clear.

Search

Important Parameters Description

1- Under Academic Load Semester: Used to filter students whom have registered hours under the normal academic load

2- Student Progress %: Used to filter students based on how fast or slow is their academic progress using the calculation (a value of 100 means a student has a normal progress rate, higher numbers mean he is progressing faster than average and lower numbers mean he is lagging behind)

3- Repeat Failed: Used to filter students based on number of times courses were repeated because the student has failed a course

4- Repeat Succeeded: Used to filter students based on number of times courses were repeated because the student wanted to improve their grade

5- Approved Courses: Used to filter students based on whether their schedules have been approved by the registration department during registration

(Note: Student whom schedules have been approved would not show up in the faculty's class list)
