BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

The Student Exit Survey is administered to all graduating students from undergraduate and postgraduate programs. The survey is designed to assist the university in assessing students' perceptions of the quality of its student learning and program effectiveness. The survey results are used to provide information to the University, Colleges, and specific program areas on the quality of their functioning. The results are evaluated annually, to provide the basis for decision-making and continuous improvement at different levels.

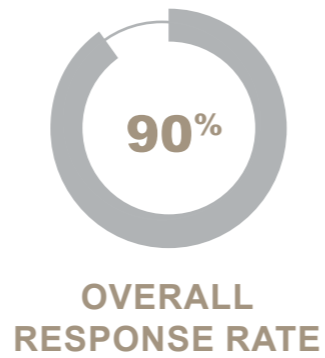
METHODOLOGY

The Student Exit Survey is designed and administered by the Quality Assurance and Accreditation Centre (QAAC). When students apply to graduate, they are required to complete an exit survey as a part of the Application for Degree process. Two versions of the survey are administered, for undergraduate students and postgraduate students, respectively. The results of the survey are presented in a report, which is published on the QAAC website. In addition, detailed survey data related to each program offered at UoB are distributed to the Colleges for detailed analysis and evaluation of college and program performance.

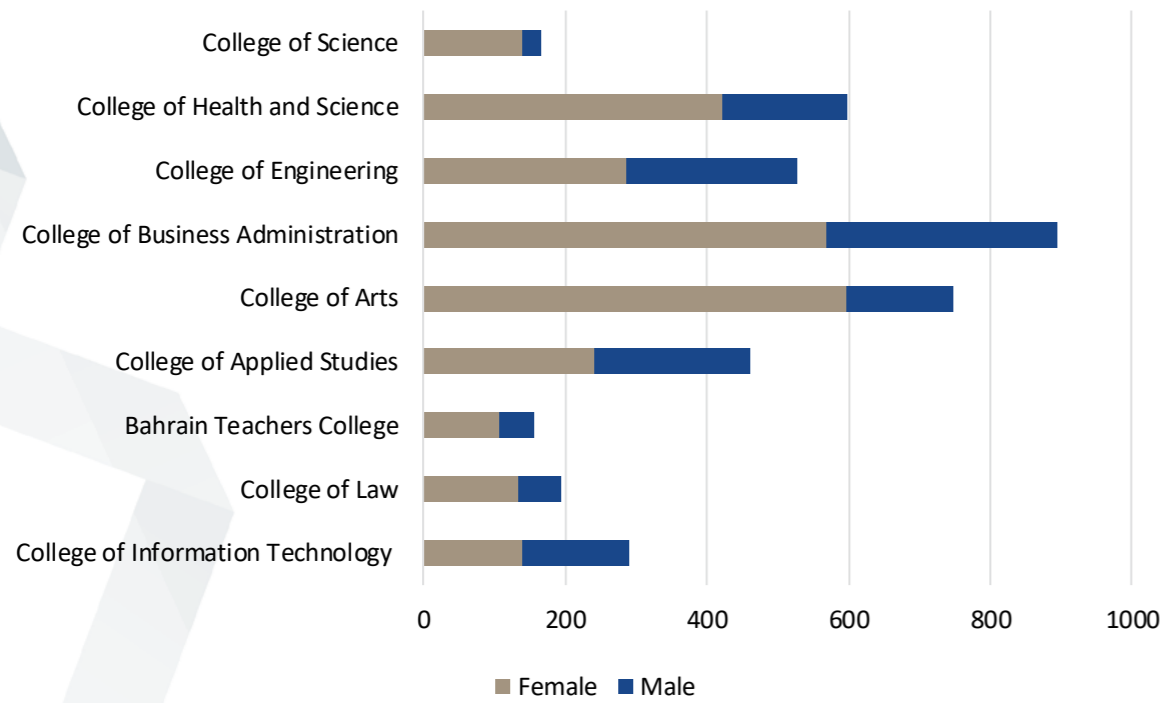


FIGURE (1): RESPONSE PER COLLEGE

AVERAGE GPA PER COLLEGE

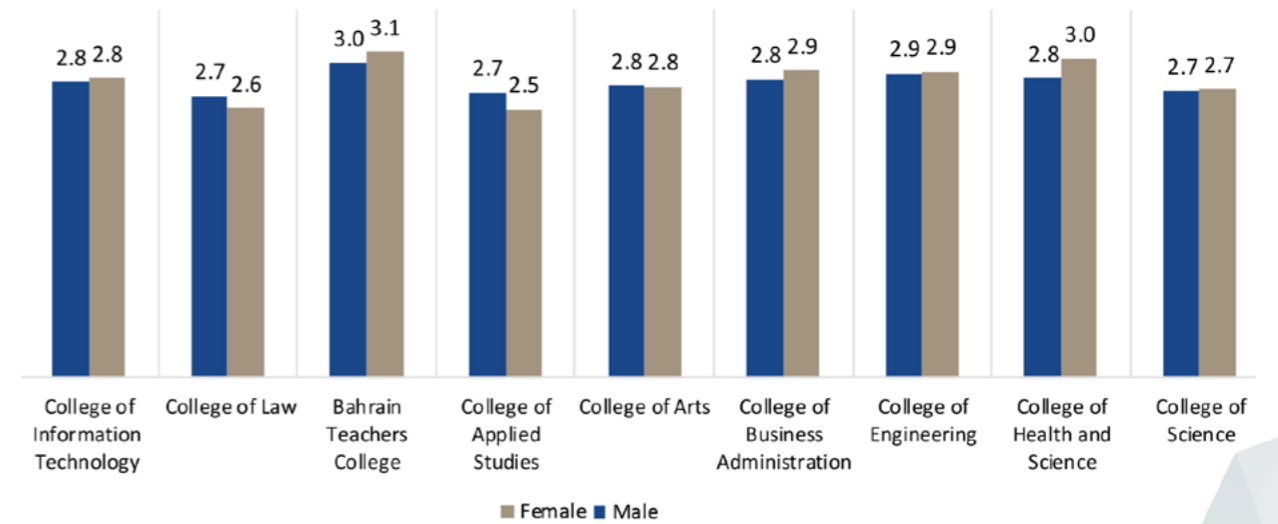


FIGURE (2): AVERAGE GPA PER COLLEGE

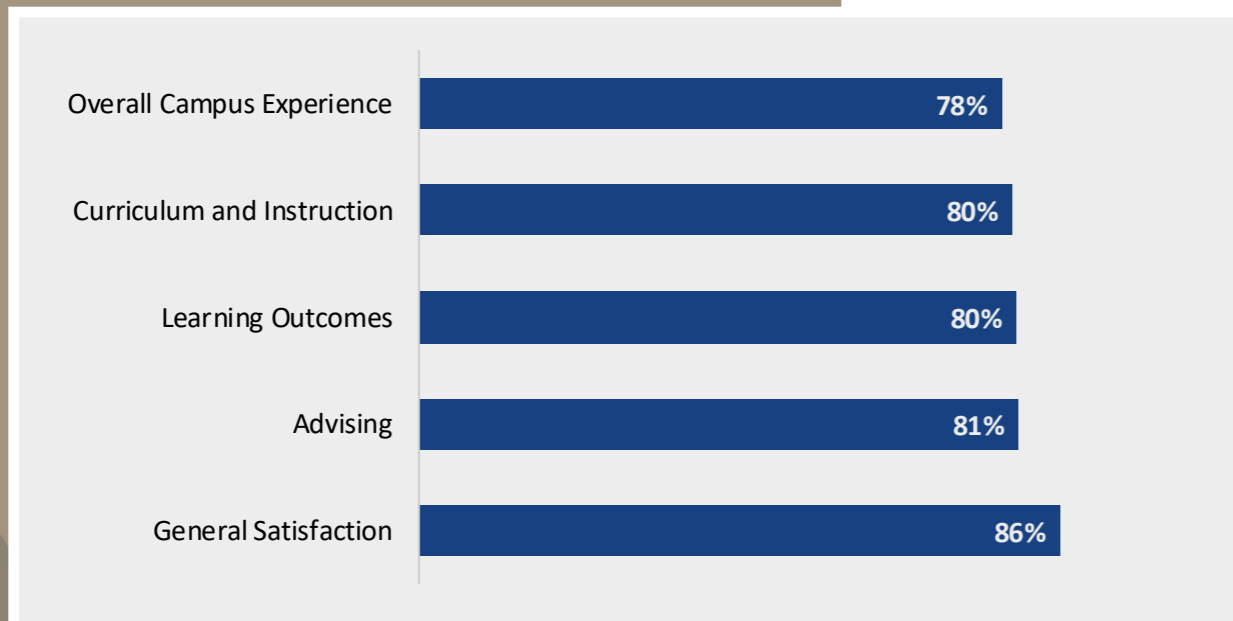
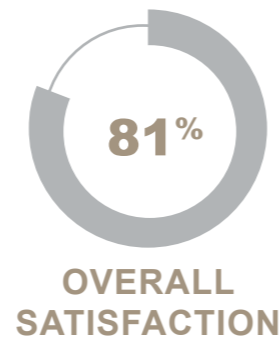


FIGURE (3): OVERALL SATISFACTION

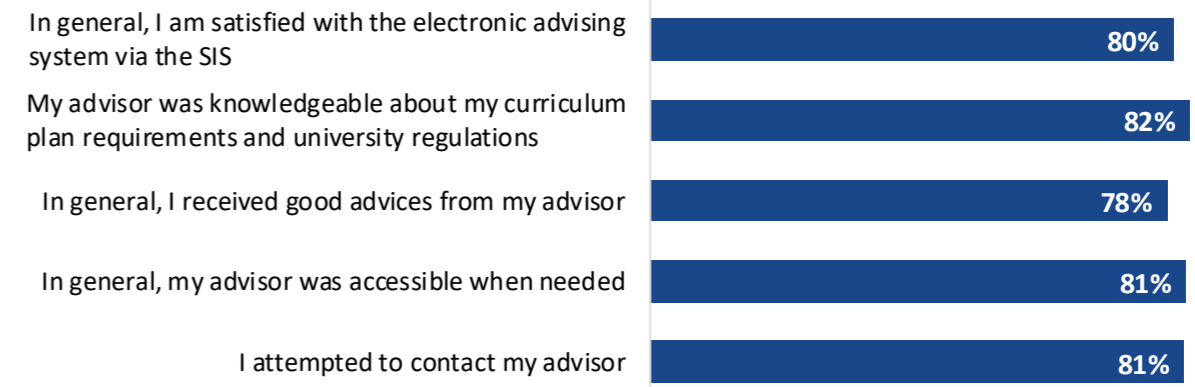
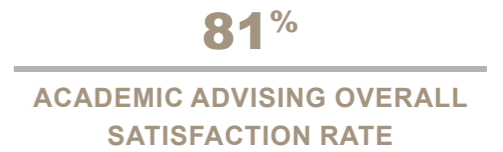


FIGURE (4) ACADEMIC ADVISING RESULTS

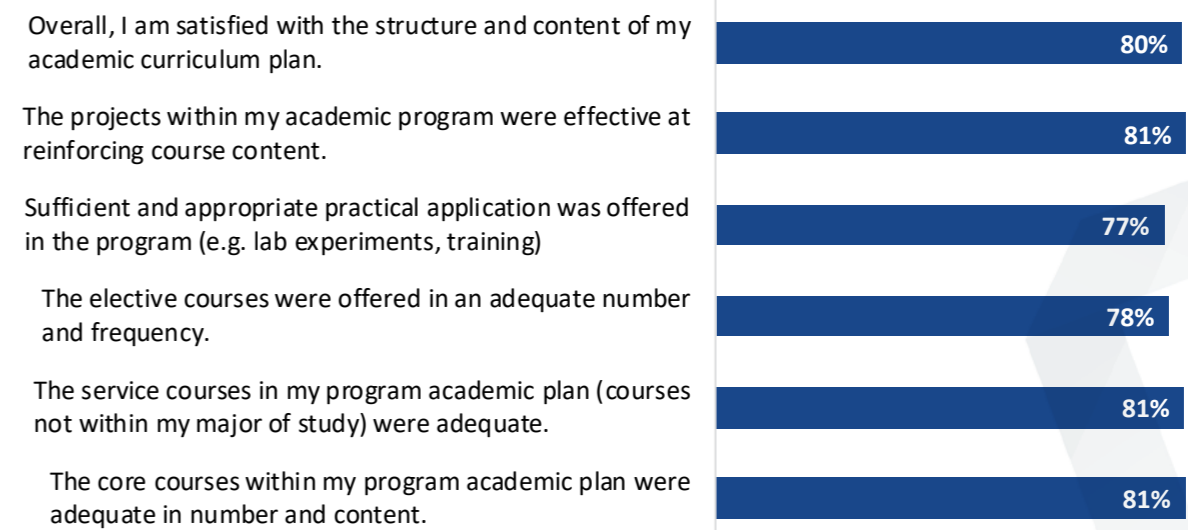


FIGURE (5) CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION RESULTS

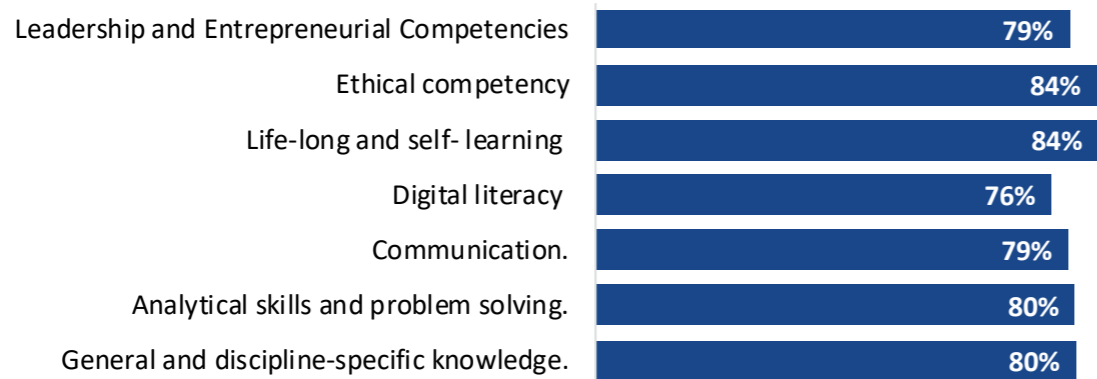


FIGURE (6) LEARNING OUTCOMES RESULTS

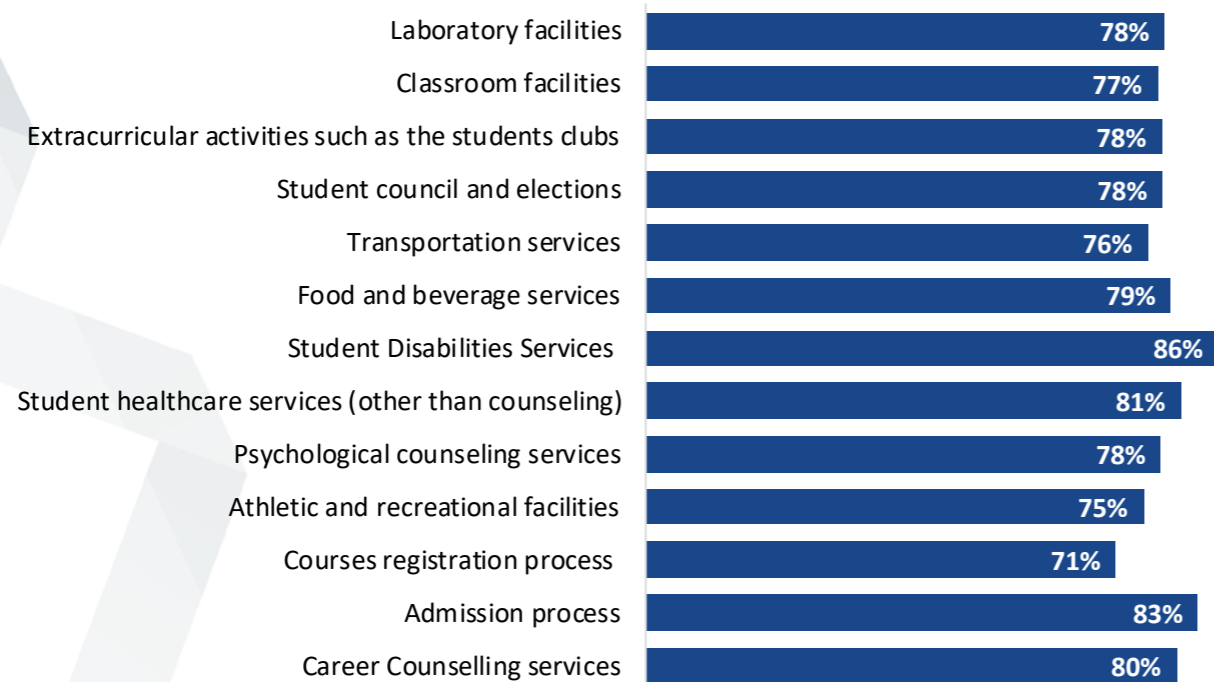
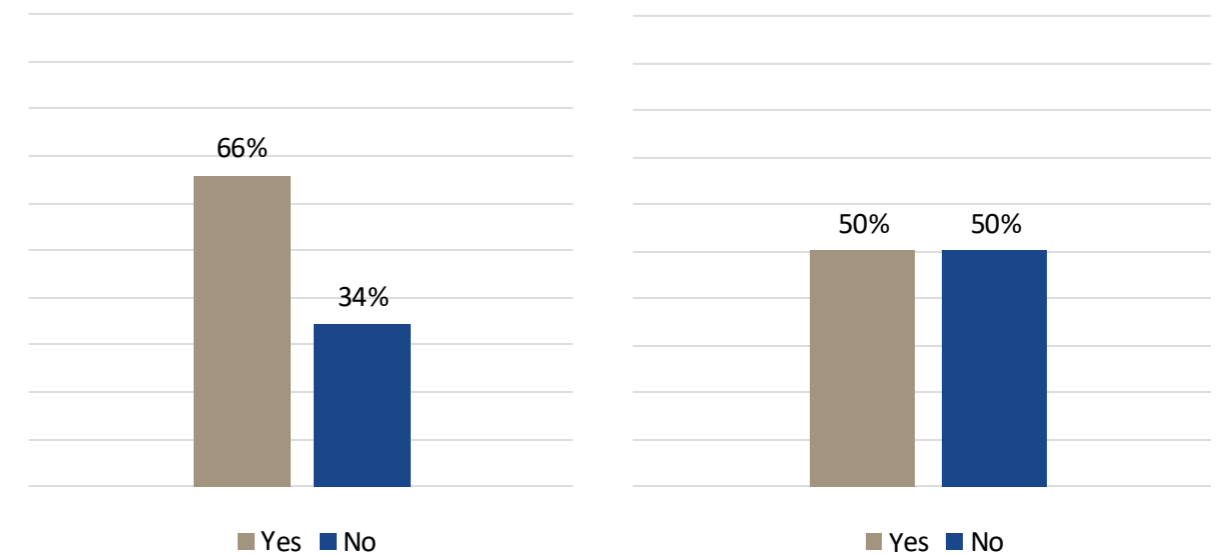


FIGURE (7) CAMPUS EXPERIENCE RESULTS

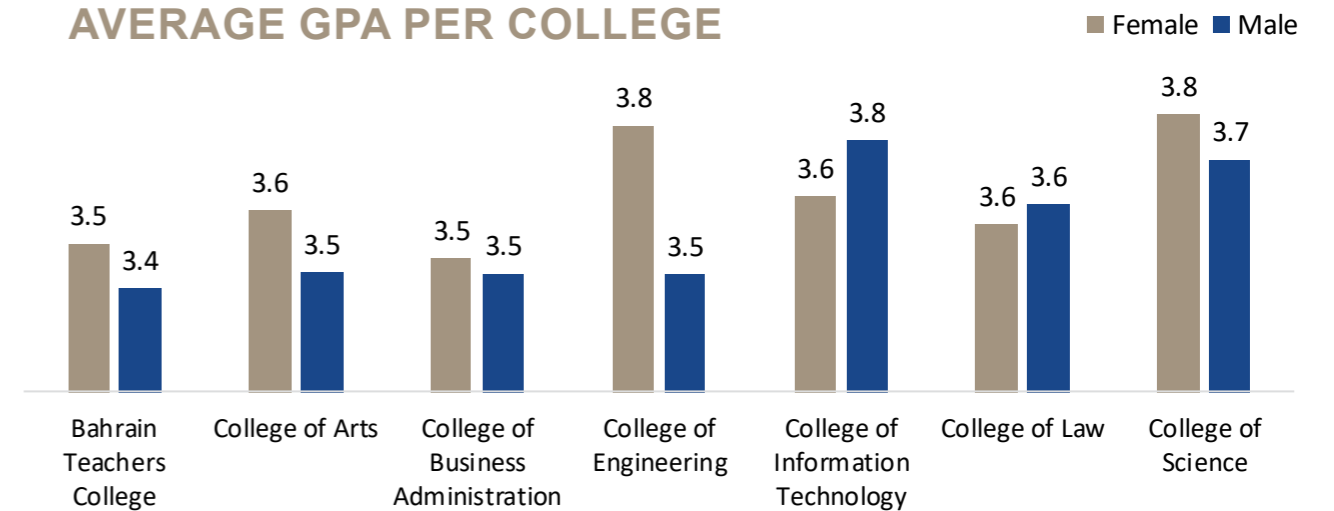
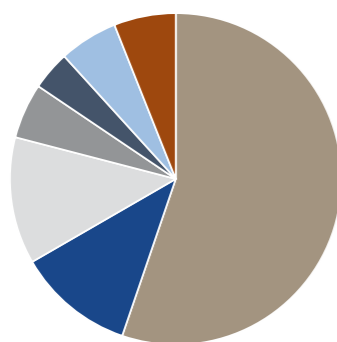


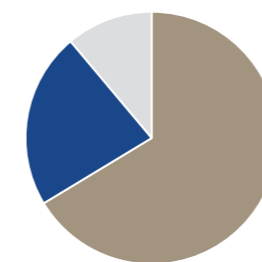
FIGURE (10): AVERAGE GPA PER COLLEGE

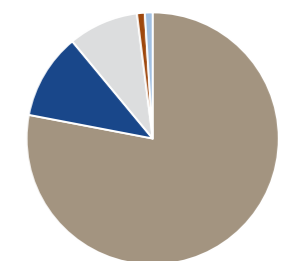

FIGURE (11): IS YOUR CURRENT EMPLOYMENT RELATED TO YOUR GRADUATE DEGREE?

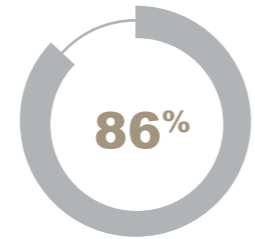

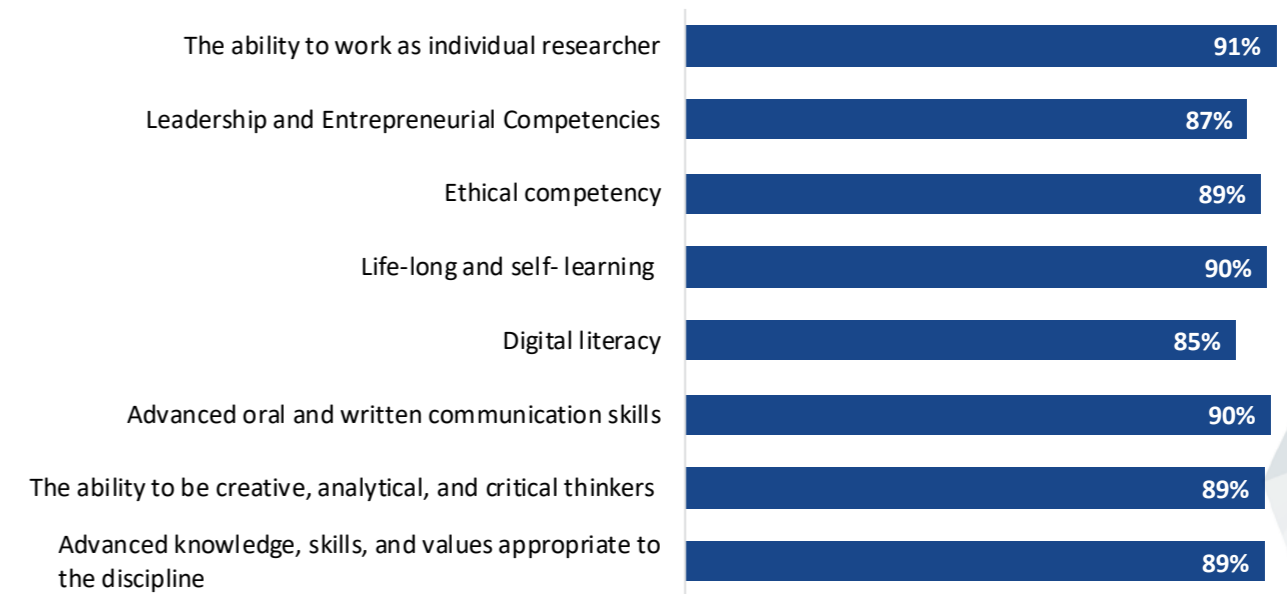


FIGURE (14) LEARNING OUTCOMES RESULTS

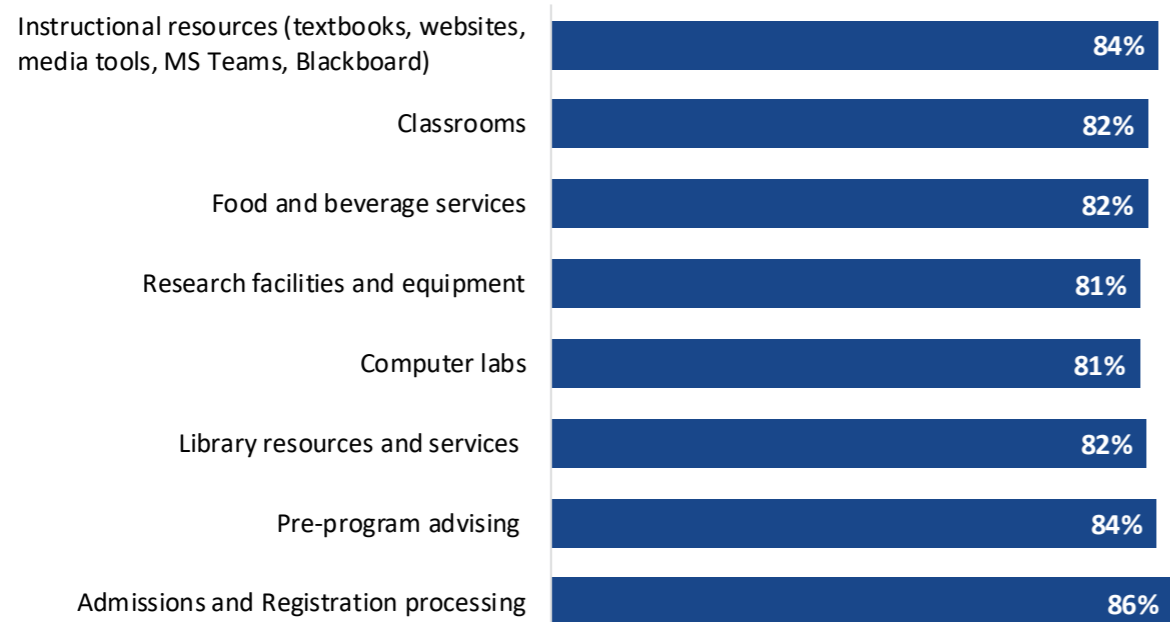


FIGURE (15) FACILITIES AND SUPPORT SERVICES RESULTS

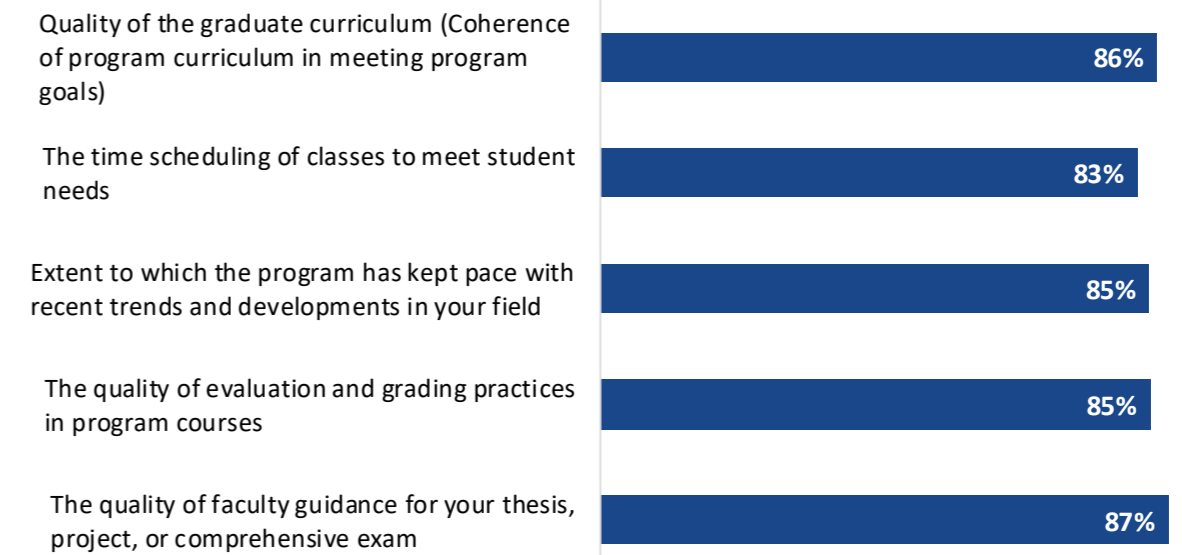
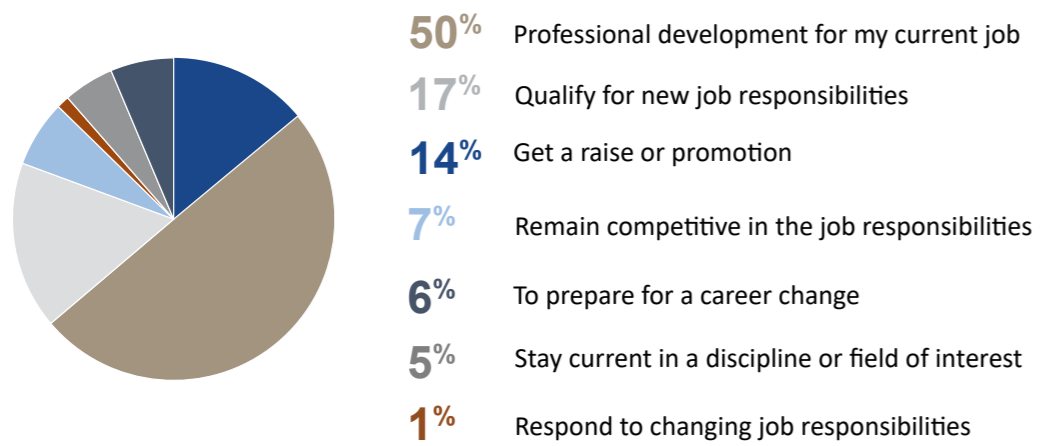
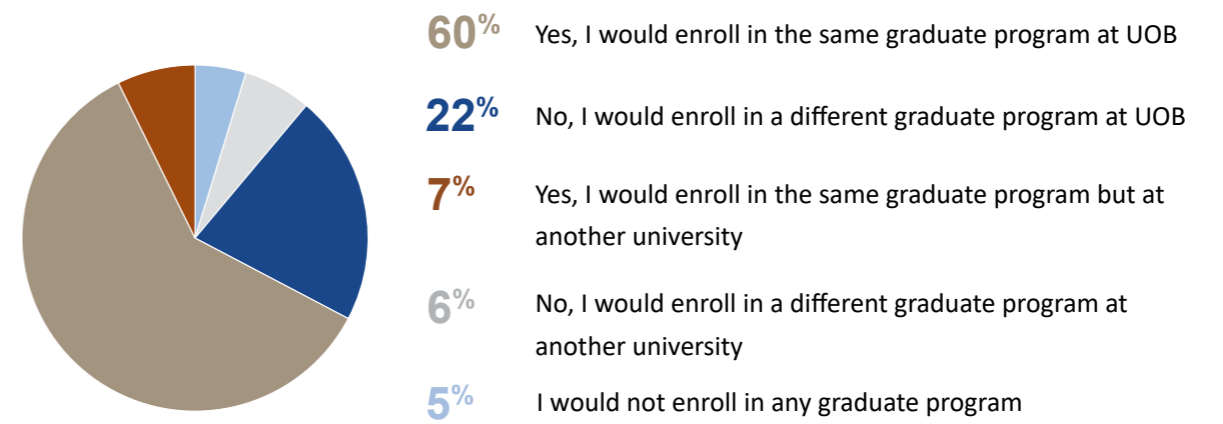


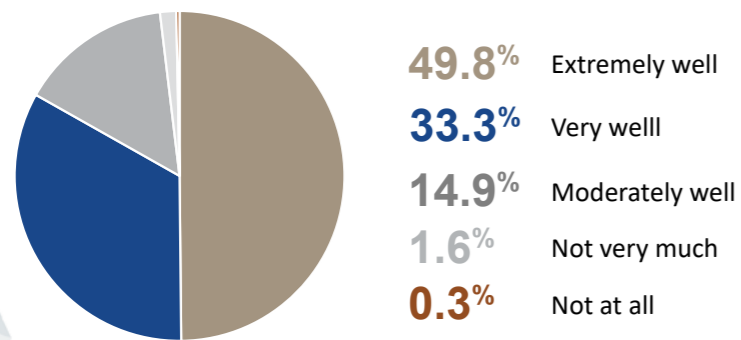
FIGURE (16) OVERALL PROGRAM EXPERIENCE RESULTS



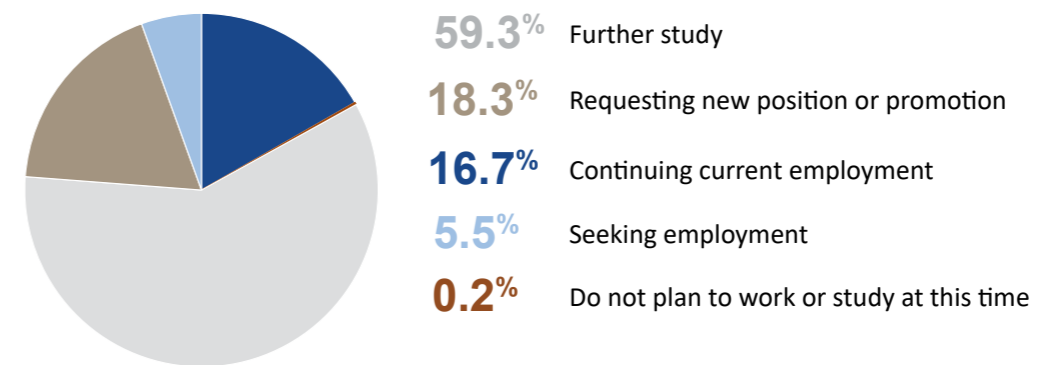
FIGURE(17): WHAT WAS YOUR PRIMARY REASON FOR ENROLLING IN YOUR GRADUATE PROGRAM?



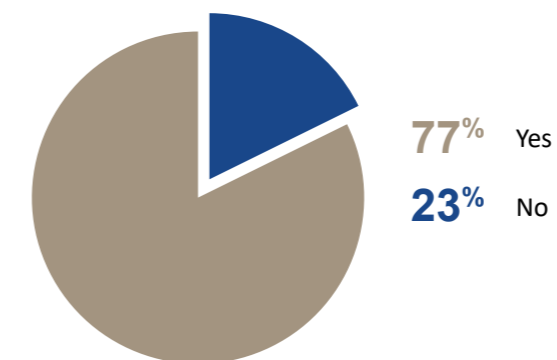
FIGURE(19): IF YOU WERE TO DO IT ALL OVER AGAIN, WOULD YOU ENROLL AGAIN IN THE SAME GRADUATE PROGRAM?

Both undergraduate and postgraduate students report high levels of satisfaction with their overall academic experience, including curriculum and instruction, learning outcomes, advising, campus experience, and facilities and support services. All areas received more than 70% positive feedback.
